## RE HUMBERSTON ACADEMY PE KIT AND VALUABLES POLICY 2018



Please find detailed below the Academy's policy on PE kit required for lessons and fixtures as well as the rules for the wearing and storing of valuables. Also detailed are the sanctions that the PE Department can apply if the policy is not followed.

### PHYSICAL EDUCATION KIT AND VALUABLES POLICY

- All students are required to bring and wear the full PE kit to each and every lesson if they are participating or not (**see the Injured or unable to participate section**). This must be in line with the school dress policy and should not include football tops or shorts, include inappropriate slogans, named tracksuit bottoms or leggings or any DRET tops that have been won in previous events. Any student who fails to bring kit will be loaned an alternative for that lesson. This must be returned at the end of the lesson and a sanction given in line with the school's PE behaviour management policy.
- If students participate in extracurricular activities then DRET tops may be worn, however when participating in fixtures they must wear kit provided by the Academy or the correct Academy PE kit. In certain fixtures like Hockey and Rugby, equipment such as gum shields and shin pads will be compulsory; the Academy does have spare equipment, but we do **STRONGLY ADVISE** your child if at all possible has their own.
- The wearing of studded footwear is recommended for football and rugby. Failure to bring appropriate equipment may result in injuries, therefore due to health and safety it is strongly advised that students wear the appropriate footwear.
- It is strongly recommended that students **do not** bring valuables to PE lessons. In the event of that being unavoidable it is the student's responsibility to look after them. The PE Learning Area will not be responsible for such items.
- The wearing of jewellery, wrist bands and watches whilst playing sport is potentially extremely harmful not only to the performer themselves but also those around them. The wearing of any such item is prohibited and any student found to be placing themselves or others at risk will receive a sanction in line with the school PE kit policy.

- Students asked to remove anything other than a watch, or pair of plain studs will be given a warning and asked to remove and rectify for the following lesson, if this is evident the following lesson they will be given an “Expectations Detention” as per the whole school behaviour policy
- Failure to remove jewellery, remove or cover up new piercings (with their own tape or plasters) will also result in a warning followed by an “Expectations Detention” if not rectified the next lesson which will take place on Tuesday or Thursday Lunch. The student will be made aware that if any injury is sustained due to this, it is their own responsibility.
- In the interest of personal safety any student with long hair performing in sport is required to tie the hair back so that vision and hearing is not impaired, no bands for hair will result in a kit mark.
- Chewing gum during the lesson will be a warning, if this is a repeated offence the Teacher responsible will give a 10 minute detention.
- Deodorant can be used after PE but must be a **ROLL ON**, no **AEROSOL** to be used, if it is used within PE it will be confiscated and collected at the end of the school day.

The student receives a break DT the same day if possible or lunch time for 10 minutes</li> <li>3. The student borrows kit from the store cupboard and still participates in the lesson</li> </ol>
3	<ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>1. A CTD will be recorded in students planner and a 20 minute lunch time detention is given, parents are contacted, recording on SIMS as above</li> <li>2. The student borrows kit from the store cupboard and still participates in the lesson</li> </ol>
	<ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>1. An ELTD will be recorded in student's planner and parents contacted, recording of this on SIMS</li> <li>2. The student borrows kit from the store cupboard and still participates in the lesson</li> </ol>

### ADDITIONAL SANCTIONS

1. If girls or boys come with items of jewellery that are not part of the Uniform policy, they will be given a warning asked to remove and rectify for the following lesson, if this is evident the following lesson they will be given an "Expectations Detention" as per the whole school behaviour policy
2. A kit mark will be given for not having the correct full PE kit, including the Humberston PE socks.
3. For any student that refuses to get changed or borrow kit, it will be a 20 minute DT at the start of lunchtime
4. Failure to remove jewellery or to cover up new piercings (with their own tape or plasters) will also result in a warning followed by a "Expectations Detention" if not rectified the next lesson which will take place on Tuesday or Thursday lunch
5. After the first warning given all kit mark detentions and "Expectations" detentions will be recorded on SIMS
