RE YEAR 11 STUDENTS - LEAVING DAY – FRIDAY 14 JUNE 2019

Traditionally we have organised a Year 11 leaving day assembly which allows students to bid farewell to their peers and teachers, within the school day. This is an opportunity to celebrate their time and remind themselves of fond memories at Humberston Academy.

The leaving day assembly for Year 11 is **Friday 14 June** at **12pm** in the hall. All students have a GCSE Physics examination in the morning of this day and we expect them to focus on this examination prior to the celebrations.

To make it a special occasion and keep with Humberston Academy tradition; students are allowed to wear appropriate fancy dress – we ask students to be mindful that there are younger students on site and that costumes should not be offensive to either other students or members of staff. **Students must arrive at school in full uniform, as they are sitting an examination.** The Academy will provide an appropriate location to change into fancy dress for students after the examination.

Students may want to bring a camera to take photographs and a book to collect messages from their teachers and peers. There will be a 'guard of honour' for our departing Year 11 students. **We expect all Year 11 students to have left the school site by 1pm.**

Normal lessons will continue in the weeks until the final assembly and it is a statutory requirement that all students attend school until this date. If the examination has been taken for the subject timetabled, we will facilitate additional revision sessions. Students should remain in full uniform for all examinations, classes and revision sessions. Students will need to return any books or equipment belonging to Humberston Academy and ask members of staff to sign that this has been done. Forms will be given to students for this purpose.

Finally, I would like to take this opportunity to congratulate Year 11 students for their commitment towards their education and the great start they have made when sitting their GCSE examinations. It is very rewarding to see such a high level of endeavour. I wish all students success in their examinations and thank you as parents and carers for your support and motivation to allow independent learning and revision to be facilitated away from Humberston Academy.
